## **LL.M (Corporate and Commercial Laws): CURRICULUM DETAILS**

### 1. LL.M. (Corporate and Commercial Laws )

As per the guidelines laid down by the University Grants Commission (UGC), a student must complete three mandatory subjects, six optional subjects and a dissertation as part of the one-year LL.M. programme. Out of the six optional courses, each student has to complete at least four optional courses in their preferred area to obtain a specialization. The University offers:

### **The LL.M. Curriculum**

The LL.M. (Master of Laws) program at MNLU-A is of one-year duration and is divided into two semesters.

### **Course Structure:**

The University offers specialization in the following area:

#### 1. Corporate and Commercial Law

The LL.M. curriculum has the following components:

- i. Foundation/Compulsory Courses
- ii. Optional/Specialization Courses and will be notified in each semester.
- iii. Dissertation

### **Foundation/Compulsory Papers:**

The Foundation Courses consist of the following three subjects/papers, which should be completed in the first semester:

### **Foundation courses**

#### **I Semester**

- A. Research Methods and Legal Writing.
- B. Comparative Public Law/Systems of Governance.
- C. Law and Justice in a Globalizing World.

#### **II Semester**

- A. 3 papers and Dissertation.
